

Brandon United Soccer Parent Code of Conduct Agreement

1. I will remember that the athletes are there to play and learn for their own fun. They are not there to entertain and they are not professional athletes.
2. I will encourage my child to play by the rules, follow the Player Code of Conduct and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
3. I will teach my child that doing one's best is as important as winning, so my child will never feel defeated by the outcome of the game.
4. I will never ridicule or yell at my child for making a mistake or losing a game.
5. I will be on my best behavior at all times and will not use profane language or harass players, coaches, referees or administrators.
6. I will never question the referee or coach's judgment or honesty in public and will respect their decisions.
7. I will show respect for the visiting team, for without them there would not be a game and I will condemn the use of violence and verbal abuse in all forms.
8. I will encourage athletes always to play according to the rules of Soccer.
9. I will attempt to relieve the pressure of competition, not increase it. A child is easily affected by outside influences.
10. I will pay all monies owing to the BUS program and the team upon request. All monies outstanding shall be due and payable within 30 days of notification. Penalties for late payments or non-payment of amounts due shall be the players' expulsion from the program.
11. I will not question the coach and or team officials in regards to any player's playing time, position(s) played, or tactical and technical components/approaches to the game at any other time other than a team meeting arranged to discuss such matters.
12. I (we) acknowledge the authority of the Brandon Youth Soccer Association (BYSA) and the BUS Code of Conduct. I understand the requirements of me as a parent to support my player/athlete, coaches, managers and officials as the program and team outlines.
13. I further understand that I (we) will abide by the BUS by-laws and the regulations established by BYSA.
